

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 507 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 24" X 21" X 2"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 8 & 17-18-12.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 39.86 CHAINS WEST TO THE 20" X 16" X 2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 7, 8, 17 & 18-18-12
 - 2) 39.86 CHAINS EAST TO THE 14" X 9" X 5" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 8, 9, 16 & 17-18-12

- 2) ARTHUR MILLIKEN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F", ON PAGE 77 DATED DECEMBER 4, 1883 FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 18, RANGE 12 FOR NEWTON WILSON, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8-18-12 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. THERE WAS NO WIDTH RECORDED ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 12-18-12 ON THE RANGE LINE TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 23 CHAINS TO INTERSECT THE LAWRENCE AND EMPORIA STATE ROAD AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 3) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 247 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 574 TO 576 PETITIONED BY NEWTON WILSON AND OTHERS OR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 18-12 [PACKET 494 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON DECEMBER 4, 1883, AND ESTABLISHED AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JANUARY 10, 1884 AS NOTED BY JOHN E. JONES, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON JANUARY 29, 1884 BY ROLAND LARKIN, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8-18-12 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 2-1/2 MILES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 14-18-12 TO BEGIN THE ROAD ALLOWED BY THE VIEWERS ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 23 CHAINS TO INTERSECT THE LAWRENCE AND EMPORIA STATE ROAD AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 4) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 40, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 40 DATED JUNE 13 & 20, 1884 AT THE REQUEST OF JONES & PARKER TO LOCATE THE CENTER CORNER, THE WEST 1/4 CORNER, AND THE NORTHEAST AND NORTHWEST CORNERS OF THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-18-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8-18-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 8-18-12 AND THE TEMPORARY LOCATION FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION-18-12 8 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 2,643.5' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 8-18-12

- 2) 2,643.5' EAST TO THE TEMPORARY LOCATION FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 8-18-12
- 3) 1,320.5' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 8-18-12
- 4) 2,641' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 8-18-12
