

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 506 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 24" X 12" X 2"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 18 & 19-18-12.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 35.58 CHAINS WEST TO THE 16" X 12" X 5" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 18 & 19-18-12 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE 22" X 20" X 2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 17, 18, 19 & 20-18-12

BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MARCH 2, 2010 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 10029-02, SURVEYS F19003 AND F19004 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-12 FOR A SURVEY OF THE WEST HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 19-18-12 FOR KEVIN DIEKER, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-18-12 FROM HIS PREVIOUS SURVEY IN 2009.
 - 1) 18.15' NORTH TO A SPIKE & SHINER IN THE TOP OF A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 2) 20.25' NW TO A SPIKE & SHINER IN THE TOP OF A BRACE POST
 - 3) 23.05' WNW TO THE TOP CENTER OF A WATER LINE SIGN
 - 4) IN LINE WITH A FENCE TO THE NORTH
 - 5) 6.0' SOUTH TO THE CENTERLINE OF THE TRAVELED WAY OF COUNTY ROAD 220 EAST-WESTHIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 2,651.78' EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 19-18-12
 - 2) 2,646.01' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 19-18-12
 - 3) 5,284.36' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 19-18-12
