GOULD, L.S. 142, AT THE NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-18-12 FROM A RETRACEMENT OF HIS SURVEY DATED 12-29-1989 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 89304.

- 1) 1,319.13' WEST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 19-18-12
- 2) 3,683.96' WEST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-18-12
- 3) 2,649.60' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 19-18-12
