- 1) ON PAGE 501 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 18" X 14" X 2"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 21 & 22-18-12.

- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 40, A SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 40 DATED JUNE 13 & 20, 1884 AT THE REQUEST OF JONES & PARKER TO LOCATE THE CENTER CORNER, WEST 1/4 CORNER, AND THE NORTHEAST AND NORTHWEST CORNERS OF THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-18-12, APPARENTLY DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-18-12 AS HE RAN THE SECTION LINES FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 8-18-12 SOUTH TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 20-18-12, AND HE DOES NOT MENTION THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-18-12.
