

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH,  
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 68 OF THE 8<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 125 DATED MARCH 24, 1875 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND THE CORNERS TO THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A POST AS STONE WAS NOT AVAILABLE** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-18-2 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 15-18-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE NOTED THAT THE PARTIES FOR WHOM THIS SURVEY WAS MADE AGREED TO REPLACE ALL OF THE POSTS THAT HE SET ON THIS SURVEY WITH STONE CORNERS.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 1,332' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-18-21
- 2) 1,332' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 15-18-2
- 3) 1,323-1/2' NORTH TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-12
- 4) 2,647' NORTH TO THE POST SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15-18-12
