

NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 497 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 24" X 10" X 3"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 15, 16, 21 & 22-18-12.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.21 CHAINS EAST TO THE 18" X 14" X 2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 15 & 22-18-12
 - 2) 80.43 CHAINS EAST TO THE 22" X 11" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 14, 15, 22 & 23-18-12

- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 26 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 102 & 103 PETITIONED BY O. RIDENOUR AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 18-12 [PACKET 122 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON MAY 30, 1879, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 60 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JULY 7, 1879, AND WAS RECORDED ON JULY 15, 1879 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 16-18-12 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 115 RODS AND 22 LINKS TO THE POINT WHERE THE LAWRENCE AND EMPORIA ROAD CROSSES THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 18-18-12 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE INTERSECTION OF THE WEST SIDE OF THE A. T. & S. F. RAILROAD AT 54 RODS EAST OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 15-18-12 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 3) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON THE BOTTOM RIGHT SIDE PAGE 164 DATED JUNE 1879, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 16-18-12 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 2 MILES AND 115 RODS, 15 LINKS WEST ON THE SECTION LINE TO THE POINT WHERE THE LAWRENCE & EMPORIA ROAD CROSSES THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 18 AT THE BEGINNING POINT OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) 1 MILES AND 54 RODS EAST ON THE SECTION LINE TO THE WEST LINE OF THE AT&SF RAILROAD AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 4) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 162 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 234 TO 236 PETITIONED BY RILEY GIBSON AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIPS 17-12 & 18-12 [PACKET 419 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON JUNE 1, 1882, WAS ESTABLISHED AT 50 FEET WIDE ON JULY 14, 1882 AS NOTED BY HUGH F. HOLMES, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND WAS RECORDED ON JULY 20, 1882 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 21-18-12 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 4 MILES TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33-17-12 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 1 MILE TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 28-18-12 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY

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- 5) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 9 DATED JUNE 1, 1882, FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIPS 17 & 18 IN RANGE 12, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 21-18-12 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 4 MILES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33-17-12 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 1 MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 28-18-12 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 6) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 53, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 234 DATED JULY 5, 1902 ORDERED BY JOHN BLAHUT, CASPER TROLL, AND THE ESTATE OF WALTER S. WILSEY TO SURVEY AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO LOCATE AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 27-18-12, SAID THAT HE DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 22-18-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. **HE SET A STAKE** FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 22-18-12 AFTER RUNNING THE SECTION LINES FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33-18-12 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE NORTH TO THE 1/8TH STONE THAT HE FOUND ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-18-12. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN HIS BOOK NUMBER 3 ON PAGE 80, AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IS IN PACKET "M 44" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 2 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 20.10 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 1/8TH STONE HE FOUND ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 16-18-12
 - 2) 80.39 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 27-18-12
 - 3) 120.58-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 24" X 12" X 2" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27-18-12
 - 4) 160.78 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 15" X 8" X 4" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 27-18-12
 - 5) 200.97-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33-18-12
 - 6) 241.15-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33-18-12 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE

- 8) THE KRETSINGER REFERENCE TIE BOOK FOR TOWNSHIP 18-12 SHOWS A **1/2" DIAMETER REBAR SET FOR THE REA** AT THE "SW CORNER SECTION 15-18-12". **MUST VERIFY AND CHECK FOR THE STONE OF RECORD BEFORE USING AS THIS IRON PIN WAS PROBABLY JUST "HEELED-IN" FOR UTILITY USE ONLY!!
