

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) G. M. WALKER, DEPUTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 35 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 69 & 70 DATED MAY 15, 1861 TO ESTABLISH THE CORNERS OF DAVID GILMORES LAND, BEING THE WEST 1/2 AND THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-18-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STAKE** FOR THE NORTH 1/4/4 POST OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-18-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 POST AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE CENTER POST OF SECTION 29-18-12 ON THIS SURVEY. HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 20.00-1/2 CHAINS WEST TO THE FOUND STONE WEST 1/4 POST OF SEC. 29-18-12
 - 2) 20.00-1/2 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE CENTER POST OF SECTION 29-18-12
 - 3) 60.03-1/2 CHAINS EAST TO THE FOUND STONE EAST 1/4 POST OF SEC. 29-18-12
 - 4) 20.10 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE POST HE SET FOR THE CENTER POST OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 29-18-12
 - 5) 40.20 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE S1/4/4 POST OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 29-18-12

- 2) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 59 DATED JUNE 7, 1883 FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 18, RANGE 12 AT THE REQUEST OF W. T. WALTERS, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-18-12 AT A TURN TO THE EAST ON THE SECOND ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. A NOTE AT THE TOP OF THE PAGE SHOWS THAT THIS ROAD WAS NOT ALLOWED ON OCTOBER 5, 1883. HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS SECOND ROAD EXTENDS NORTH FOR 1/2 MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 29-18-12 TO BEGIN THE SECOND ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS SECOND ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE FOR 30 FEET FOR A TURN TO THE SOUTH ON THE SECOND ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 3) **REA PIN—MUST VERIFY AND CHECK FOR THE STONE OF RECORD BEFORE USING; THIS IRON PIN WAS PROBABLY JUST "HEELED-IN" FOR UTILITY USE ONLY!! SEE REA BOOKS 30 & 31. WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR**
 - 1) 21' NORTH TO A WITNESS

- 4) THE KRETSINGER REFERENCE TIE BOOK FOR TOWNSHIP 18-12 SHOWS A **REA PIN** AT THE "SW CORNER SE1/4 NW1/4 SECTION 29-18-12". **VERIFY AND CHECK FOR THE STONE OF RECORD BEFORE USING!! WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR**
 - 1) 21' NORTH TO A WITNESS [REA]

- 5) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 63 TO LOCATE AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 29-18-12, THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-18-12, AND THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-18-12 PETITIONED BY PAUL G. WALKER, RECORD OWNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 AND THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-18-12 THAT BEGAN ON MAY 10, 1988 AND CONTINUED UNTIL COMPLETED ON JUNE 29, 1988, SAID THAT HE EXCAVATED WITH A COUNTY MAINTAINER FOR THE STAKE THAT WAS SET BY WALKER AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE

SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-18-12, BUT NO MONUMENT WAS FOUND. NO
MONUMENT WAS SET ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
