WALKER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1857 TO 1860, IN SURVEY NUMBER 16 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 9 DATED AUGUST 6, 1858, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER POST OF SECTION 31-18-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STAKE** FOR THE CENTER POST OF SECTION 31-18-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE 1/4 STONE POSTS HE FOUND ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH LINES OF SECTION 31-18-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 39.91 CHAINS NORTH TO THE FOUND NORTH 1/4 STONE POST OF SEC. 31-18-12
 - 2) 39.91 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE FOUND SOUTH 1/4 STONE POST OF SEC. 31-18-12
