

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 70 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 18" X 11" X 6"** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-18-12 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY ON DECEMBER 12, 1856.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 18" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-18-12
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 36" X 12" X 6" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 18 & 19 SOUTH, RANGES 11 & 12 EAST AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31-18-12

- 2) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 49 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 145 & 146 DATED MAY 12 & 13, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY BISHOP AND OTHERS, BEING SECTION 36-18-10, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND DIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER AND SOUTHWEST QUARTER INTO 40 ACRE LOTS, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-18-11 ON THE RANGE LINE AND EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 36-18-11 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 36-18-11 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE ON THIS SURVEY.
