- 1) ON PAGE 502 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 24" X 15" X 2"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 31 & 32-18-12.
- 2) JAMES MEANS, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1865 TO 1867, IN SURVEY NUMBER 1 IN THE 4<sup>TH</sup> TERM RECORDED ON PAGE 86 IN SURVEY BOOK "A" DATED NOVEMBER 10, 1865 TO ESTABLISH THE SOUTH AND WEST [1/4] CORNERS OF SECTION 32-18-12 AND ALSO THE CENTER OF SECTION 32 AT THE REQUEST OF CHARLES ARCHER, SAID THAT **HE ESTABLISHED** THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-18-11 ON THIS SURVEY. HE DID NOT INDICATE IF HE SET A STONE FOR THIS CORNER.
