

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 04, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH,
RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 71 OF THE 8TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 128 DATED APRIL 26, 1875 TO SUBDIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 4-18-13, SAID THAT **HE SET A POST** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 4-18-13 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE 15" X 10" X 3" STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 4-18-13 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-18-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THE SURVEY WAS NOT SIGNED AND DID NOT APPEAR TO HAVE BEEN COMPLETED.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,320' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 4-18-13
- 2) 1,320' WEST TO THE 15" X 10" X 3" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 4-18-13
- 3) 3,960' WEST TO THE TEMPORARY WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-18-13
