

CENTER CORNER SECTION 05, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 135 ON THE RIGHT PAGE DATED APRIL 4, 1882 FOR A PLAT OF SURVEY TO DETERMINE THE AREAS NOT IN THE RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-18-13, SAID THAT HE DETERMINED THE **LOCATION FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 5-18-13 TO BE ON LINE AND EQUIDISTANT DISTANCE FROM THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNERS ON THE EAST AND WEST LINE OF SECTION 5-18-13**, BUT HE DID NOT SAY IF HE SET A STONE AT THIS CORNER ON THIS SURVEY. HE CALCULATED THAT THERE WERE 77.19 ACRES NORTHWEST OF THE RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY AND 74.38 ACRES SOUTHEAST OF THE RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY.

HIS NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 39.79 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-18-13
- 2) 39.79 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-18-13 THAT FALLS IN THE RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY
