

**NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 91 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 22" X 13" X 3"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 7 & 18-18-13 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY ON DECEMBER 27, 1855.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 22" X 10" X 3-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-18-13
  - 2) 80.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 20" X 14" X 3-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 18 & 19-18-13
  - 3) 37.84 CHAINS EAST TO THE 22" X 12" X 2-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET ON THE WEST BOUNDARY OF THE SAC & FOX RESERVATION
  - 4) 39.84 CHAINS EAST TO THE 20" X 10" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 7 & 18-18-13
  - 5) 79.84 CHAINS EAST TO THE 17" X 15" X 3-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 7, 8, 17 & 18-18-13
- 2) H. S. SLEEPER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1859 TO 1862, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A" ON PAGE 26 FOR THE "FOREST HILL TO WATERLOO ROAD" [PACKET 164 I THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE] THAT WAS SURVEYED MARCH 15 & 16, 1859 AND ESTABLISHED ON APRIL 4, 1959 IN COMMISSIONERS JOURNAL ON PAGE 59, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 13-18-12 ON THE RANGE LINE ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 13-17-12 AT A TURN TO THE NORTHEASTERLY TO THE SOUTH LINE OF WATERLOO TOWNSITE
- 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-18-12 AT A TURN TO THE SOUTHWESTERLY TO THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-19-12 AT A TURN TO THE SOUTH ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE TO THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12-19-12 AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE TOWN OF FOREST HILL TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 3) ARTHUR MILLIKEN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F", ON PAGE 77 DATED DECEMBER 4, 1883 FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 18, RANGE 12 FOR NEWTON WILSON, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 12-18-12 ON THE RANGE LINE TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY. THERE WAS NO WIDTH RECORDED ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE INTERSECTION OF THE EMPORIA & LAWRENCE ROAD AT 23 CHAINS WEST OF THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8-18-12 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 4) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 574 AND 575 FOR ROAD NUMBER 247 BY A PETITION BY NEWTON WILSON [PACKET 494 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] DATED JANUARY 1884, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 12-18-12 ON THE RANGE LINE TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY FOR A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD. **[NOTE: THE FIRST TWO MILES OF THIS ROAD GOING EAST WERE NOT ALLOWED. WARREN CHP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR]]**

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- 5) MATTHEW BROWN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1888 TO 1900, AND 1914, BY J. MAX YINGLING, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A PERMANENT SURVEY RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 1 ON PAGE 85 AT THE ORDERED BY EDWIN D. JONES TO PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 13-18-12, THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 12 & 13, THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTION 13 & 14, AND SUCH OTHER CORNERS OF SAID SECTION 13-18-12 AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE SET A 20" X 8" X 6" LIMESTONE MARKED WITH A CROSS ON THE NORTH SIDE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 13-18-12 ON THE RANGE LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THE SURVEY WAS MADE UPON THE 5<sup>TH</sup>, 6<sup>TH</sup>, 7<sup>TH</sup> AND 8<sup>TH</sup> OF JUNE, 1911 AND ENTERED ON AUGUST 19, 1911. SEE ALSO PACKET "M 167" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER 8 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.

HIS NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 2,643'-3" SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE 24" X 14" X 10" LIMESTONE MARKED WITH A CROSS ON THE TOP HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13-18-12
- 2) 5,286'-6" SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE 18" X 8" X 6" LIMESTONE MARKED WITH A CROSS ON THE NORTH SIDE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 13-18-12
- 3) 2,617' WEST TO THE 18" X 8" X 4" LIMESTONE MARKED WITH A CROSS ON THE NORTH SIDE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER SEC. 13-18-12
- 4) 5,234' WEST TO THE 24" X 9" X 4-1/2" LIMESTONE MARKED WITH A CROSS ON THE NORTH SIDE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 13-18-12
