BROSEMER, L.S. 82, IN SURVEY F28001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-13 DATED AUGUST 27, 1983 TO SURVEY AND MONUMENT THE SOUTH HALF OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 28-18-13 FOR GARY MOUNKES, SAID IN HIS *REPORT OF SURVEY* THAT **HE SET A 4 X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "BROSEMER LS 82" CAP** FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTH HALF OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 28-18-13 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE CALCULATED POSITION FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 28-18-13 AND THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28-18-13.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,310.37' NORTH TO THE CALCULATED POSITION FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 28-18-13
- 2) 1,310.37' SOUTH TO THE #5 REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28-18-13
- 3) 2,656.07' EAST TO THE #4 REBAR WITH HIS "LS 82" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE S1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 28-18-13
