

**WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 90 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 11" X 3"** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-18-13 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY ON DECEMBER 27, 1855.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 21" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-18-13
- 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 22" X 15" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 18 & 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 & 13 EAST AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31-18-13

- 2) H. S. SLEEPER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1859 TO 1862, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A" ON PAGE 26 FOR THE "FOREST HILL TO WATERLOO ROAD" [PACKET 164 I THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE] THAT WAS SURVEYED MARCH 15 & 16, 1859 AND ESTABLISHED ON APRIL 4, 1959 IN COMMISSIONERS JOURNAL ON PAGE 59, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-18-12 ON THE RANGE LINE ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 13-17-12 AT A TURN TO THE NORTHEASTERLY TO THE SOUTH LINE OF WATERLOO TOWNSITE
- 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTHWESTERLY TO THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-19-12 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AT A TURN TO THE SOUTH ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE TO THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12-19-12 AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE TOWN OF FOREST HILL TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 3) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED FEBRUARY 14, 2001, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 00379-02, SURVEY F36003 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-12 FOR THE SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 36-18-12, SAID THAT HE DEEMED THAT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-18-12 ON THE RANGE LINE WAS **LOST**. **HE SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-18-12 ON THE RANGE LINE AT HALFWAY BETWEEN THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 36-18-12.

- 1) 27.8' EAST TO A 40 D NAIL & WASHER IN A CORNER FENCE POST
- 2) 31.3' SE TO A 40 D NAIL & WASHER IN A FENCE POST
- 3) 16.2' WEST TO A CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER IN A CORNER FENCE POST
- 4) 4.7' EAST TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF THE GRAVEL ROAD NORTH-SOUTH

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 2,644.71' NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE 1/2" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 36-18-12
- 2) 2,644.71' SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE 1" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 36-18-12 ON THE TOWNSHIP CORNER
- 3) 2,630.52' WEST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 36-18-12
- 4) 2,752.52' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR A TRACT CORNER
- 5) 2,932.61' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR A TRACT CORNER

- 6) 3,943.83' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 36-18-12
- 7) 5,257.14' WEST TO THE #6 SQUARE REBAR HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-18-12
