

**CENTER CORNER SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F33001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-13 DATED JULY 23, 2014, FOR JOB NUMBER 14148-02, THE SURVEY OF TWO TRACTS IN THE SOUTH 1/2 OF SECTION 33-18-13, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT HE DETERMINED THE **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 33-18-13 TO BE AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE QUARTER CORNERS, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED DUE TO TREES. HE NOTED THAT THE **TRUE POSITION** FELL 3.7' NORTH AND 1.7' WEST OF AN EXISTING CORNER POST.
- HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 50 FEET SOUTH TO THE 1/2" X 24" IRON PIN WITH HIS "PS 752 S. BROSEMER" CAP HE SET FOR A WITNESS CORNER
  - 2) 2,642.56' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 33-18-13 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE, AND THE P.O.B. OF THE SOUTH TRACT
  - 3) 1,317.01' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "PS 752 S. BROSEMER" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 33-18-13
  - 4) 2,634.02' WEST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 33-18-13
  - 5) 2,649.88' NORTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 33-18-13
  - 6) 1,325.34' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "PS 752 S. BROSEMER" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 33-18-13 THAT FELL IN LINE WITH FENCES TO THE SOUTH AND WEST EXTENDED
  - 7) 2,650.68' EAST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 33-18-13

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
