BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F06001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-10 TO SURVEY THE WEST LINE OF THE EAST HALF OF THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 6-19-10 FOR PAUL HANCOCK DATED MAY 21, 2009 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 09136-02, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 6-19-10 TO BE AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE QUARTER CORNERS, BUT THIS POSITION WAS **NOT MONUMENTED** ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 659.78' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE E1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF SEC. 6-19-10
- 2) 1,319.56' WEST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 6-19-10
- 3) 2,597.32' WEST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-19-10 ON THE RANGE LINE
- 4) 2,680.35' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-19-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
- 5) 2,638.27' EAST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 6-19-10
- 6) 2,641.16' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH AN ALUMINUM KDOT CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 6-19-10
