

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 06, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 46 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 30" X 6" X 3"** FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-19-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE ON NOVEMBER 27, 1856.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 39.90 CHAINS WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 30" X 17" X 3" LIMESTONE WITH A MOUND OF ROCKS THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 18 & 19 SOUTH, RANGES 9 & 10 EAST ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-19-10
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 28" X 8" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 5 & 6-19-10
- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MAY 21, 2009 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 09136-02, SURVEY F06001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-10 TO SURVEY THE WEST LINE OF THE EAST HALF OF THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 6-19-10 FOR PAUL HANCOCK, SAID THAT HE DUG AND PRODDED FOR THE STONE AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-19-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE, BUT HE DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE. HE DEEMED THAT THIS CORNER WAS **OBLITERATED**. **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-19-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AFTER HE DETERMINED THAT AN EXISTING CORNER FENCE POST WAS IN A REASONABLE POSITION.
 - 1) ON THE EAST SIDE OF A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 2) IN LINE WITH FENCES NORTH, SOUTH AND WEST
 - 3) 10.6' WEST TO A CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER IN A BRACE POST
 - 4) 15.1' SOUTH TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN THE SOUTH GATE POST
 - 5) 14.5' NORTH TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN THE NORTH GATE POSTHIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,323.83' WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 6-19-10
 - 2) 2,641.04' WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 6-19-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE
 - 3) 2,639.76' EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 6-19-10
 - 4) 2,680.35' SOUTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE E1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 6-19-10
 - 5) 5,231.51' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH AN ALUMINUM KDOT CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 6-19-10
