

CENTER CORNER SECTION 07, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 101 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 194 DATED MARCH 18, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND IN SECTION 7-19-10, TO ESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE WESTERN BOUNDARY, ALSO THE CENTER CORNER, AND ALSO THE SUBDIVISIONAL CORNER ON THE WESTERN BOUNDARY OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-19-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 7-19-10 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 159 RODS, 6 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-19-10
 - 2) 160 RODS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-19-10
- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED APRIL 06, 2003, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 03042-02, SAID THAT HE CONSIDERED THAT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 7-19-10 WAS **OBLITERATED**. **HE SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 7-19-10 BASED ON THE PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OF TWO INTERSECTING LINES OF HEDGE. THE STONE FROM A PRIOR SURVEY BY D. T. McAULEY DATED 1869 AND RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 194, WAS SEARCHED FOR BUT **NOT** FOUND. HE SAID THAT THIS POSITION FITS THE DISTANCES AND ALIGNMENT FROM THE PRIOR McAULEY SURVEY.
- 1) 16.30' NE TO A 40 D SPIKE & WASHER IN A 9" HACKBERRY TREE
 - 2) 9.85' NNW TO A 40 D SPIKE & WASHER IN A 9" RED ELM TREE
 - 3) IN LINE WITH A LINE OF HEDGE TO THE NORTH
 - 4) IN LINE WITH A LINE OF HEDGE TO THE EAST
- 3) JEFFREY A. KUBOTA, L.S. 1538, OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING CONSULTANTS, P.A., IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED DECEMBER 7, 2011 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 11A30, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 7-19-10 BY REFERENCE REPORTS PROVIDED BY THE KANSAS STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY. HE HAD THE FOLLOWING **HORIZONTAL TIES:**
- 1) 16.26' NE TO A 40 D SPIKE & WASHER IN A 9" ELM TREE
 - 2) 9.82' NNW TO A 60 D SPIKE IN THE SOUTHWEST FACE OF A 9" ELM TREE
 - 3) 3.86' EAST TO A 60 D SPIKE IN THE NORTH FACE OF A 36" DIAMETER MULTI-TRUCK HEDGE TREE
 - 4) IN LINE WITH A LINE OF HEDGE TO THE NORTH
 - 5) IN LINE WITH A LINE OF HEDGE TO THE EAST
