

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER SECTION 07, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F06001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-10 TO SURVEY THE WEST LINE OF THE EAST HALF OF THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 6-19-10 FOR PAUL HANCOCK DATED MAY 26, 2009 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 09136-02, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-19-10 BASED ON A PRORATION TO THE GLO BETWEEN THE SOUTHWEST CORNER AND THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-19-10, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,283.52' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH AN ALUMINUM KDOT CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 6-19-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE
- 2) 657.73' EAST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE E1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 6-19-10 AS WITNESSED BY THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET AT 30' NORTH
- 3) 1,315.46' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH AN ALUMINUM KDOT CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 6-19-10
- 4) 2,653.04' NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 6-19-10
