

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 09, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 44 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 140 AND DATED MAY 1, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY W. L. PHILIPS AND OTHERS, BEING SECTION 9-19-10, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER, DIVIDE THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 INTO TWO 80'S RUNNING EAST AND WEST, AND TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 INTO AN 80 RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH AND TWO 40'S, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 9 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONES HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER AND WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 80 RODS, 7-1/2 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9
- 2) 80 RODS, 7-1/2 LINKS SOUTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 9
