

CENTER CORNER NORTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 8, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 8 DATED FEBRUARY 26-27, 1884 AT THE ORDER OF A. QUAKENBUSH AND J. H. THOMAS TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 10-19-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT 1/8TH CORNERS ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH SIDES OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,318' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10
 - 2) 1,318' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10
 - 3) 3,638' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10
 - 4) 3,958' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10

BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F10007 RECORDED IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE FOR PROJECT NUMBER 99249-02 AND DATED NOVEMBER 5, 1999 SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE FOUND A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10 FROM A PREVIOUS SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,313.73' NORTH TO THE PERMANENT SURVEY STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10
 - 2) 1,313.73' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10 FROM HIS PREVIOUS SURVEY

BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED FEBRUARY 01, 2005, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 05007-02, SURVEY F10012 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-10 FOR TWO TRACTS IN THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 10-19-10 FOR PEGGY STICE, SAID THAT **HE FOUND A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** AT THE CENTER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10 FROM A PREVIOUS SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,313.85' NORTH TO THE STONE AND 5/8" REBAR OVER THE TOP AND ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10
 - 2) 407.35' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE EAST TRACT
 - 3) 853.79' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 14 ACRES OF THE NW1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10 FROM HIS PREVIOUS SURVEY
