- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 8, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 8 DATED FEBRUARY 26-27, 1884 AT THE ORDER OF A. QUAKENBUSH AND J. H. THOMAS TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 10-19-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT 1/8TH CORNERS ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH SIDES OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,320' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10
- 2) 1,320' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10
- 3) 2,638' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10
- 4) 3,956' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10
