

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 8, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 8 DATED FEBRUARY 26-27, 1884 AT THE ORDER OF A. QUAKENBUSH AND J. H. THOMAS TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 10-19-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 10-19-10 ON LINE AND EQUAL DISTANCE BETWEEN THE STONE HE THAT SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 10-19-10 AND THE GOVERNMENT STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 10-19-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

- 3) 2,297.46' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF "EXCEPTION TWO"
- 4) 2,527.46' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10 FROM A PREVIOUS SURVEY

- 1) 5/8" REBAR ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE STONE
- 2) 34.75' NW TO A SPIKE & WASHER IN A POWER POLE
- 3) 28.30' SOUTH TO THE NEAR FACE OF A PIPE POST
- 4) 43.10' SW TO A SPIKE & WASHER IN A POWER POLE
