

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED OCTOBER 31, 1991, FOR JOB NUMBER 90125-02, SURVEY F10005 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-10 FOR A SURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISION OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 10-19-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10 ON TRUE LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE CENTER CORNER AND THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 10-19-10.

- 1) IN LINE WITH A HEDGE TO THE NORTH
- 2) 21.0' SOUTH TO A LINE OF FENCE EAST-WEST
- 3) 29.7' NNW TO A CONCRETE NAIL & SHINER IN A POWER POLE
- 4) 3.6' NORTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF THE ROAD EAST-WEST

- 4) 2,629.85' NORTH TO THE #5 REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10

- 1) 25.2' NORTH TO A 40 D SPIKE & WASHER IN A CORNER FENCE POST
- 2) 47.7' NE TO A 40 D SPIKE & WASHER IN A POWER POLE
- 3) 5.0' WEST TO A HEDGE TO THE NORTH
- 4) 21.0' SOUTH TO A LINE OF FENCE EAST-WEST
- 5) 3.6' NORTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF COUNTY ROAD 175 EAST-WEST
