

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 8, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 8 DATED FEBRUARY 26-27, 1884 AT THE ORDER OF A. QUAKENBUSH AND J. H. THOMAS TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 10-19-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10 ON THIS PERMANENT SURVEY.**

- 4) WARREN CHIP WOODS, P.L.S. 603, LYON COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MARCH 18, 2015 FOR LYON COUNTY PROJECT NUMBER 15-26, THE REPLACEMENT OF TIMBER CULVERT 931.1-518.5 WITH AN 18.33' SPAN ALL-STEEL CULVERT, **FOUND THE 1/2" REBAR WITH "L.S. 752" CAP AT 3" DEEP** AT THE NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10 FROM INFORMATION AND MEASUREMENTS IN SURVEY F10007 DATED NOVEMBER 5, 1999 AND SURVEY F10008 DATED DECEMBER 20, 1999 BY STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, WITH BOTH SURVEYS RECORDED IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-10 IN THE RECORDS ROOM IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY ENGINEER. THIS 1/16TH CORNER IS AT PROJECT CENTERLINE STATION 23+17.03.
- 1) 3.0' NORTH TO THE CENTERLINE OF THE TRAVELED WAY OF GRAVEL COUNTY ROAD 175 EAST-WEST
 - 2) 19.30' SSE TO THE MAG NAIL & WASHER SET IN A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 3) 32.10' WSW TO THE MAG NAIL & WASHER SET IN THE NORTH FACE OF A POWER POLE
 - 4) 23.70' NORTH TO THE MAG NAIL & WASHER SET IN THE SOUTH FACE OF A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 5) 43.45' NE TO THE MAG NAIL & WASHER SET IN THE GATE POST
 - 6) IN LINE WITH A FENCE EXTENDED TO THE NORTH
 - 7) 1.0' EAST TO THE FENCE LINE EXTENDED TO THE SOUTH
 - 8) 1,117.06' WEST TO THE 5/8" X 1' REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP SET FOR PROJECT CENTERLINE STATION 11+99.97
 - 9) 1,317.03' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH A KDOT ALUMINUM CAP FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 10-19-10 AT PROJECT CENTERLINE STATION 10+00.00
 - 10) 1,316.94' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH A KDOT ALUMINUM CAP FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 10-19-10 AT PROJECT CENTERLINE STATION 36+33.97
