

**CENTER CORNER SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 50, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 231 DATED MAY 20, 1902 ORDERED BY G. A. BIDDLE TO SURVEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE CENTER CORNER ND NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13-19-10 AND RUN SUCH LINES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE AT THE INTERSECTION OF HEDGES** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 13-19-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE RAN THE SECTION LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS, AND HE SAID "THIS STONE WAS SO NEARLY CORRECT THAT I RECOGNIZED IT AS THE **TRUE CORNER**" AND **HE MADE A PLUS ("+" ) ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE STONE** AS A WITNESS. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN HIS BOOK NUMBER 3 ON PAGE 72, AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IS IN PACKET "M 90" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 4 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.
