

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 50, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 231 DATED MAY 20, 1902 ORDERED BY G. A. BIDDLE TO SURVEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE CENTER CORNER ND NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13-19-10 AND RUN SUCH LINES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 1/8<sup>TH</sup> STONE** ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 13-19-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN HIS BOOK NUMBER 3 ON PAGE 72, AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IS IN PACKET "M 90" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 4 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 19.98 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 13-19-10
- 2) 19.98 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13-19-10
- 3) 59.94 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 13-19-10 ON THE RANGE LINE
