- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 8, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 8 DATED FEBRUARY 26-27, 1884 AT THE ORDER OF A. QUAKENBUSH AND J. H. THOMAS TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 10-19-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 10-19-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 10-19-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

- 1) 20.02-1/2 CHAINS [1,321-1/2'] WEST TO THE GOVERNMENT STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 10-19-10
- 2) 20.02-1/2 CHAINS [1,321-1/2'] EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 10-19-10
- 3) 80.10 CHAINS [3,964-1/2'] EAST TO THE GOVERNMENT STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 10-19-10
- 4) 1,320' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10
- 5) 2,640' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10
- 6) 3,958' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10
- 7) 5,276' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-19-10
