

CENTER CORNER SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, BY D. W. BOWMAN, DEPUTY, IN SURVEY NUMBER 46 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 142 DATED MAY 2 & 6, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY PHILLIPS, LEWIS, STOUT AND OTHERS, BEING SECTION 16-19-10, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER, TO DIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 INTO TWO 80'S RUNNING NORTH & SOUTH, TO DIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 INTO TWO 80'S RUNNING NORTH & SOUTH, AND TO LAY OFF A PORTION OF LAND 20 RODS WIDE ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-19-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 16-19-10 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS SURVEY.
- 2) REA BOOK 31 ON PAGE 15 SHOWS THAT **THEY FOUND THE STONE** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 16-19-10 AT 2,637 FEET SOUTH OF THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16-19-10. THE STONE IS 5' SOUTH OF A FENCE TO THE EAST AND ON LINE WITH A FENCE TO THE WEST.
 - 1) 15' WEST TO A WITNESS PIN 2" OR 3" EAST OF A FENCE POST
- 3) THE KRETSINGER REFERENCE TIE BOOK FOR TOWNSHIP 19-10 SHOWS A **REA PIN** AT THE "SW CORNER NE1/4 SECTION 16-19-10", BUT REA BOOK 31 ON PAGE 15 SHOWS A **STONE** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 16-19-10 WITH THE SAME TIE TO THE WITNESS PIN. **VERIFY AND CHECK FOR THE STONE OF RECORD BEFORE USING!! WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR**
