BOWMAN, DEPUTY, IN SURVEY NUMBER 46 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 142 DATED MAY 2 & 6, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY PHILLIPS, LEWIS, STOUT AND OTHERS, BEING SECTION 16-19-10, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER, TO DIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 INTO TWO 80'S RUNNING NORTH & SOUTH, TO DIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 INTO TWO 80'S RUNNING NORTH & SOUTH, AND TO LAY OFF A PORTION OF LAND 20 RODS WIDE ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-19-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE 6 RODS NORTH OF TRUE LINE** OF THE SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-19-10 ON THIS SURVEY AS TRUE LINE FALLS IN THE RIVER.
