

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, BY D. W. BOWMAN, DEPUTY, IN SURVEY NUMBER 48 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 144 DATED MAY 9, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY WM. EIKENBERRY AND OTHERS, BEING SECTION 17-19-10, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND DIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 EQUALLY BY A LIE RUNNING EAST AND WEST, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE WES LINE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 17 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE STONE HE SET FOR THE CENTER OF SECTION 17 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 80 RODS, 3 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17
- 2) 80 RODS, 3 LINKS SOUTH TO THE STONE SET FOR THE CENTER OF SECTION 17
