

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MAY 17, 2003, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 03169-02, SAID THAT HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP FOR THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 18 ON TRUE LINE BETWEEN THE NORTHEAST AND SOUTHEAST CORNERS OF SECTION 18, AND AT 1/4 THE DISTANCE.

- 1) 25.15' SW TO A 40 D NAIL & WASHER IN A 20" HACKBERRY TREE
- 2) 34.60' NW TO A 40 D NAIL & WASHER IN THE WEST TRUNK OF A TRIPLE 10" BOX ELDER TREE
- 3) 5.5' WEST TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY NORTH-SOUTH OF COUNTY ROAD "B" [MINIMUM MAINTENANCE]

HIS DRAWING ON HIS REFERENCE REPORT SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 1,321.35' NORTH TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 18
- 2) 3,964.03' SOUTH TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 18
