

**CENTER CORNER SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 162, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 162 DATED APRIL 4 & 8, 1887 AT THE ORDER OF DANIEL DRAKE TO LOCATE THE EAST AND WEST LINE THROUGH THE WEST 1/2 OF SECTION 18-19-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 18-19-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED JANUARY 04, 2007, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 06304-02, SURVEY F18006 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-10 FOR THE SURVEY OF A 5 ACRE TRACT IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 18-19-10 FOR DIANNE LAMBERT AND GLADYS M. PENDERGRAFT, SAID THAT HE EXCAVATED WITH A COUNTY BACKHOE FOR THE STONE AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 18-19-10, BUT HE DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE. HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 18-19-10 BY RETRACING THE EDMISTON 1887 SURVEY, I.E. ON TRUE LINE BETWEEN THE NORTH 1/4 AND THE SOUTH 1/4 AND ON LINE FROM THE WEST 1/4 STONE OVER THE EDMISTON STONE HE FOUND, BUT HE DID **NOT MONUMENT** THE POSITION ON THIS SURVEY.
  - 1) 1,265.62' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND THAT WAS SET BY EDMISTON IN 1887 IN BOOK "E" ON PAGE 162
  - 2) 2,588.18' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 18-19-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE THAT WAS SET BY EDMISTON IN 1887 IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 162
  - 3) 2,632.16' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH KDOT ALUMINUM CAP HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 18-19-10
