

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, BY D. W. BOWMAN, DEPUTY, IN SURVEY NUMBER 61 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 160 & 161 DATED MAY 28, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY NEWITT AND OTHERS, BEING SECTION 16-19-10, TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 INTO TWO EQUAL PARTS BY A LINE RUNNING NORTH & SOUTH, TO DIVIDE THE WEST 1/2 OF THE 1/4 INTO TWO EQUAL PARTS BY A LINE RUNNING EAST AND WEST, AND TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 INTO 5 LOTS, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-19-10 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST AND SOUTH 1/4 CORNERS OF SECTION 16-19-10 ON THIS SURVEY. HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 80 RODS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 16-19-10
 - 2) 80 RODS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16-19-10
