

**WEST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 35 OF THE 8<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 90 DATED JULY 23, 1874 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 21-19-10 AND SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 INTO 4 EQUAL PARTS, SAID THAT **HE SET A 13" X 5" X 2" STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 21 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE 16" X 10" X 2" STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER AND THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 16 & 21 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING DISTANCE:**

- 1) 981-1/8' EAST TO A 15" X 10" X 5" STONE HE SET FOR A PROPERTY DIVISION CORNER
