

**WEST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 35 OF THE 8<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 90 DATED JULY 23, 1874 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 21-19-10 AND SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 INTO 4 EQUAL PARTS, SAID THAT THE PERMANENT 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 21 FALLS IN THE RIVER. HE SET THE FOLLOWING **WITNESS STONES** ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**:
  - 1) 99' SOUTH TO A 18" X 14" X 3" WITNESS STONE HE SET ON THE SECTION LINE
  - 2) 136' WEST TO A 14" X 8" X 3" WITNESS STONE HE SET ON THE EAST-WEST CENTERLINE OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 21
