

**NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 200 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 19" X 12" X 2-1/2"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 15 & 22-19-10.  
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 39.99 CHAINS WEST TO THE 25" X 7" X 5" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 14, 15, 22 & 23-19-10
  - 2) 39.99 CHAINS EAST TO THE 20" X 12" X 2-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 13, 14, 23 & 24-19-10
  
- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED APRIL 2, 1999, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 99029-02, [LYON COUNTY PROJECT NUMBER 98-2Z, SITE 2], LARGE SURVEY SR #22002 IN THE SURVEY DRAWER FOR TOWNSHIP 19-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE GLO STONE AT 32" DEEP** AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 23-19-10. **HE SET A 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP OVER THE STONE.**
  - 1) 24.0' ESE TO A 1/2" REBAR
  - 2) 49.6' SSE TO A 1/2" REBAR
  - 3) 68.2' WNW TO A 1/2" REBAR ON THE NORTH EDGE OF THE ROADHIS DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 5,293.53' WEST TO THE GLO STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22-19-10
  
- 3) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED FEBRUARY 2, 2003, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 02461-02, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP OVER THE GLO STONE** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14-19-10 FROM HIS EXISTING TIES OF RECORD IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE DATED APRIL 1999.
  - 1) 20.0' EAST TO A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS CAP SET
  - 2) 20.0' NORTH TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS CAP FOUND
  - 3) 24.0' ESE TO A 1/2" REBAR FOUND IN A FIELD ENTRANCE
  - 4) 49.6' SSE TO A 1/2" REBAR FOUND IN THE EAST LANE OF THE TRAVELED WAY OF THE DIRT ROAD
  - 5) 68.2' WNW TO A 1/2" REBAR FOUND 2.0' NORTH OF THE NORTH EDGE OF THE DIRT ROAD
  - 6) 4.0' NORTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF THE ROAD EXTENDED FROM THE WESTHIS DRAWING ON HIS REFERENCE REPORT SHOWS THE FOLLOWING:
  - 1) 2,641.00' EAST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP OVER THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14-19-10
  - 2) 5,269.70' EAST TO THE 1" IRON PIN HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 14-19-10
