

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 96 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 191 DATED MARCH 11, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND SITUATED IN SECTION 19-19-10, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER OF THE SECTION, AND THE CENTER CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4, AND THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4, AND THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SAID SECTION 19-19-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-19-10 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-10 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 80 RODS, 14 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-10
 - 2) 80 RODS, 14 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-10
- 2) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 97 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 192 DATED MARCH 12, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND SITUATED IN SECTION 30-19-10, TO SURVEY THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE THAT HE HAD PREVIOUSLY SET** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-10 ON THIS SURVEY.

- 3) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A" ON PAGES 145 & 146 ON THE PETITION OF MILTON LINDLEY AND OTHERS FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 19-10 THAT WAS SURVEYED ON JANUARY 22, 1870 AND ESTABLISHED AND RECORDED ON FEBRUARY 15, 1970 BY DAVID S. GILMORE, COUNTY CLERK, FOR A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT THIS ROAD RUNS NORTH-SOUTH ON THE MIDDLE LINE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-19-10. SEE THE COMMISSIONERS JOURNAL ON PAGE 311.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE MIDDLE LINE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 18-19-10 TO THE STONE ON THE SOUTH BANK OF THE COTTONWOOD RIVER
 - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE 1/16TH SECTION LINE TO THE CENTER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-10 AT A TURN TO THE EAST
- 4) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN A REPORT OF A **PERMANENT SURVEY** IN SECTION 19-19-10 MADE PRIMARILY TO LOCATE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE WEST 1/2 OF SECTION 19-19-10 THAT WAS BEGUN ON APRIL 16, 1969 AND WAS COMPLETED ON APRIL 24, 1969 AND RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 53 AND RECORDED IN VOLUME 2 OF PLATS ON PAGE 58 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON AUGUST 27, 1969, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE SET AN IRON PIN** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-19-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,320' EAST TO THE TEMPORARY POINT HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-10

- 4) 3,955.8' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE

NORTH SIXTEENTH CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 30-19-10
