

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 163, A SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 130 DATED NOVEMBER 23-25, 1887 TO ESTABLISH THE EAST LINE AND THE CORNERS OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 24" X 8" X 2-1/2" LIMESTONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE NORTH FACE** FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-10 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,311' WEST TO THE STONE "SET BY SOMEONE" HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE THAT HE FOUND TO BE 9" TOO FAR NORTH AND 18" TOO FAR WEST AFTER HE RAN THE RANGE LINE FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-10 TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-10
 - 2) 3,973' EAST TO THE TEMPORARY STAKE HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-10
 - 3) 9,253' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 29-19-10
 - 4) 1,321-3/4' SOUTH TO THE 18" X 10" X 6" LIMESTONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE WEST FACE HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-10
 - 5) 2,643-1/2' SOUTH TO THE 14" X 12" X 4" LIMESTONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE WEST FACE HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-10
 - 6) 3,965-1/4' SOUTH TO THE 18" X 8" X 7" LIMESTONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE WEST FACE HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-10
 - 7) 5,287' SOUTH TO THE 18" X 11" X 2-1/2" LIMESTONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE NORTH FACE WITH A BROKEN PINT BOTTLE IN THE HOLE WHEN THE STONE WAS SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-10
- 2) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN A REPORT OF A **PERMANENT SURVEY** IN SECTION 19-19-10 MADE PRIMARILY TO LOCATE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE WEST 1/2 OF SECTION 19-19-10 THAT WAS BEGUN ON APRIL 16, 1969 AND WAS COMPLETED ON APRIL 24, 1969 AND RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 53 AND RECORDED IN VOLUME 2 OF PLATS ON PAGE 58 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON AUGUST 27, 1969, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE SET AN IRON PIN** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-19-10 AT 3,960 FEET WEST OF THE TEMPORARY POINT HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE NOTED ON THIS SURVEY "STATE STATUTE RULES THAT WHEN CLOSING ON A BASE LINE THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTH HALF OF THE SECTION MUST BE 40 CHAINS OR 2,640 FEET. IN THIS CASE THE WEST COUNTY LINE IS THAT BASE LINE, THUS THE 80 ACRE TRACTS RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH WOULD BE STANDARD WIDTH EXCEPT THE WESTERN TIER WHICH TAKES THE SHORTAGE OR THE EXCESS." THERE ARE NO TIES ON THE SURVEY.

- 1) 1,515.8' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE
- 2) 1,320' EAST TO THE IRON PIN HE SET FOR PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-10
- 3) 2,640' EAST TO THE IRON PIN HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 19-19-10
- 4) 3,960' EAST TO THE TEMPORARY POINT HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-10
- 5) 1,322.62' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-10
