

**WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 31 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 23" X 10" X 4"** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-10 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE ON NOVEMBER 19, 1856.  
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 27" X 11" X 5" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 19 & 30-19-10
  - 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 30" X 15" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-19-10
  
- 2) ROAD RECORD BOOK "C" ON PAGES 62 TO 65 FOR ROAD NUMBER 278 [PACKET 507 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] DATED DECEMBER 1884, CONCERNS THE CASE OF SARAH F. LOCKERMAN VS. M. A. COPPOCK , ET AL, "WHEREIN IT WAS DECIDED BY SAID COURT THAT THERE HAD BEEN ESTABLISHED IN THE YEAR 1860, A ROAD FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-10 TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 30, SAME TOWNSHIP AND RANGE", A TRANSCRIPT OF WHICH IS ON PAGE 65.
  
- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 163, A SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 130 DATED NOVEMBER 23-25, 1887 TO ESTABLISH THE EAST LINE AND THE CORNERS OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE ON THIS SURVEY.  
HIS NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 2,645-3/4' NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE "SET BY SOMEONE" HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-10, THAT HE FOUND TO BE 9" TOO FAR NORTH AND 18" TOO FAR EAST AFTER HE RAN THE RANGE LINE FROM THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-10 TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-10
  - 2) 5,290' NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-10
  - 3) 2,640' SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-10, THAT WAS SET BY WILLIAM MURRY
  - 4) 7,925' SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31-19-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
  
- 4) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 78, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 158 DATED JULY 14 & 15, 1903 AT THE REQUEST OF J. ROSECRANTS FOR A SURVEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE EAST 1/2 AND THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 31-19-10 AND RUN SUCH LINES AS ARE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE TO BEGIN THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN HIS BOOK 3 ON PAGE 186 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD

BOOKS, AND THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 69" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 3 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.05 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE LOCATION FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31-19-10
  - 2) 80.10 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO A FLAG HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-19-10, AS THE SURVEYOR OF CHASE COUNTY WAS NOT THERE SO HE COULD SET A STONE
  - 3) 120.15 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31-19-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
- 5) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN A REPORT OF A **PERMANENT SURVEY** IN SECTION 19-19-10 MADE PRIMARILY TO LOCATE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE WEST 1/2 OF SECTION 19-19-10 THAT WAS BEGUN ON APRIL 16, 1969 AND WAS COMPLETED ON APRIL 24, 1969 AND RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 53 AND RECORDED IN VOLUME 2 OF PLATS ON PAGE 58 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON AUGUST 27, 1969, DOES **NOT** MENTION THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-10 AS HE RAN THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-10 NORTH TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
