

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 97 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 192 DATED MARCH 12, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND SITUATED IN SECTION 30-19-10, TO SURVEY THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 30, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** SET BY A PREVIOUS SURVEYOR AT THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 30 ON THIS SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCE:
 - 1) 159 RODS, 1 LINK EAST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 30

- 2) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN A SURVEY RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 53 AND DATED APRIL 24, 1969, SHOWS A **STONE** AT THE WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 30 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
