

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 71 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 286 TO 288 PETITIONED BY E. T. McCOY AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN SECTION 30-19-10 THAT HE SURVEYED ON APRIL 7, 1880, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JULY 13, 1880, AND WAS RECORDED ON JULY 13, 1880 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-10 ON THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE FOR THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST FOR 3,941 FEET TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-10 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
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- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON THE LEFT SIDE PAGE 184 DATED APRIL 7, 1880, FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 19-10, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-10 ON THE CHASE COUNTY LINE FOR THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS 3,941' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-10 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
