SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN A LEGAL SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 158 AND DATED JULY 1903, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE WITH BROKEN GLASS BY THE STONE** AT THIS "1/2/4 CORNER SET BY BROWN" [MATTHEW BROWN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1888 TO 1900, AND 1914] ON THIS **LEGAL SURVEY**. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN HIS BOOK 3 ON PAGE 186 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS, AND THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 69" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 3 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.
