

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) SAMUEL P. DAVIES, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 46, SURVEY 129 OF THE 7<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 45 DATED MAY 13, 1870 TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 25-19-10 INTO 2 EQUAL PARTS BY A LINE PASSING NORTH & SOUTH THROUGH IT, SAID THAT **HE SET A POST** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 25-19-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 25-19-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

- 1) 5.5' EAST TO A LINE OF HEDGE TO THE SOUTH EXTENDED
  - 2) 6.5' NORTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF COUNTY ROAD 140 EAST-WEST
  - 3) 16.6' SOUTH TO A 40 D NAIL & WASHER IN A POWER POLE
  - 4) 1,326.12' WEST TO THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER [OF SECTION 36-19-10]
  - 5) 1,326.12' EAST TO THE NORTH EAST CORNER [OF SECTION 36-19-10]
