

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 01, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) S. K. McCrary, Deputy County Surveyor, in Survey Number 123, a **PERMANENT SURVEY** recorded in Survey Book "F" on page 204 dated April 28, 1905 for the purpose of locating and permanently establishing the corners and boundaries of lots 9, 10, 11 & 12 in Mrs. Lewis Addition to the City of Emporia ordered by W. A. Willis, agent for the owners of the above property, said that **HE SET A STONE** for the permanent southeast corner of the west 1/2 of the northeast 1/4 of section 1 on line and halfway between the stone he set for the permanent center corner and the stone he set for the permanent northeast corner of the southeast 1/4 of section 1 on this **PERMANENT SURVEY**. His field notes are in book 2 on page 174 in the "Kretsinger Collection" of field books, and there is additional information in packet "M 173" in miscellaneous drawer number 1 in the vault in the County Engineer's Office. [**NOTE:** See the survey as his notes and drawing do not show the same chaining numbers – Warren Chip Woods, L.S. 603, County Surveyor]

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 4.99-1/4 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE EAST 60 ACRES OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 1
- 2) 19.98-1/4 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 1 ON LINE WITH A HEDGE RUNNING EAST AND A WIRE FENCE RUNNING WEST
- 3) 4.99-3/4 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 60 ACRES OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 1
- 4) 19.99-3/4 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE MARKED "1/4" HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 1, FROM WHICH A 10" OAK TREE BEARS 5 LINKS EAST, AND A 5" OAK TREE BEARS 2 LINKS EAST
- 5) 39.98-3/4 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 1 AT 1 LINK WEST OF A BURR OAK TREE [**NOTE:** SHOULD BE THE NW1/4 – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR]
- 6) 59.97-3/4 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1, FROM WHICH A 12" WALNUT TREE BEARS 42 LINKS EAST AND 5 LINKS SOUTH, AND A COFFEE BEAN TREE BEARS NORTHWEST AT 45 LINKS
