

CENTER CORNER SECTION 02, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) G. M. WALKER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1857 TO 1860, IN SURVEY NUMBER 15 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 10 DATED JULY 12, 1858, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER POST OF SECTION 2-19-11 SAID THAT THE CENTER OF SECTION 2 FALLS IN THE NEOSHO RIVER. HIS NOTES STATE: "DID NOT CORRECT CENTER POST AS IT WOULD STAND IN THE RIVER 95 LINKS WEST OF STAKE ON RANDOM LINE 40 CHAINS FROM SOUTH LINE".

- 2) G. M. WALKER, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 32 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 66 DATED JANUARY 10, 1861 TO DIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 2-19-11 INTO EAST AND WEST HALVES AND ESTABLISH THE NECESSARY BOUNDS AND CORNERS, SAID THAT **HE LOCATED THE CENTER POST** OF SECTION 2 THAT FALLS IN THE NEOSHO RIVER ON THIS SURVEY AS PER SURVEY NUMBER 15 IN THE 1ST TERM. HE NOTED THE FOLLOWING WITNESS TREES:
 - 1) WHITE ELM 12" DIAMETER N. 33-3/4° E. 49 LINKS
 - 2) WHITE ELM 24" DIAMETER N. 83°50' W. 1.17-1/2 CHAINS

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

 - 1) 19.94 CHAINS EAST TO A STONE SET FOR THE S1/4/4 POST OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 2
 - 2) 39.88 CHAINS EAST TO THE FOUND STONE EAST 1/4 POST OF SECTION 2

- 3) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED SEPTEMBER 21, 2005, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 05-306-02, SURVEY F02001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR SECTIONS 1-8 IN TOWNSHIP 19-11 FOR THE NORTH LINE OF A TRACT IN SECTION 2-19-11 FOR FARM & HOME/FLOTT/WHITE, SAID THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE CENTER OF SECTION 2 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS, BUT IT WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

 - 1) 2,639.51' WEST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 2
 - 2) 2,568.45' NORTH TO A 5/8" REBAR FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 2
 - 3) 2,629.84' EAST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 2
 - 4) 2,644.12' SOUTH TO A 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 2
