

CENTER CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 02, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 45, A PERMANENT SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 44 DATED MAY 3, 1870 TO RUN OUT THE LINES OF A 20 ACRE TRACT OF LAND LOCATED IN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 2-19-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STAKE** FOR THE 1/4/4 CORNER AT THE CENTER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 2 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 AND THE POST HE SET FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 2 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 1,320' SOUTH TO A POST SET FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 2
- 2) 1,320' NORTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE EAST & WEST LINE PASSING THROUGH THE CENTER OF SECTION 2
- 3) 660' EAST TO A POST SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE 20 ACRE TRACT

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
