

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 02, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) G. M. WALKER, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 32 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 66 DATED JANUARY 10, 1861 TO DIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 2-19-11 INTO EAST AND WEST HALVES AND ESTABLISH THE NECESSARY BOUNDS AND CORNERS, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE NORTH 1/4/4 POST OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 2-19-11 LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT STONE POSTS HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 2 ON THIS SURVEY.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
  - 1) 19.94 CHAINS WEST TO THE FOUND STONE NORTH 1/4 POST OF SECTION 2
  - 2) 19.94 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE POST FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 2
  - 3) 38.72 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE SET FOR THE S1/4/4 POST OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 2
  
- 2) G. M. WALKER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY DEPUTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 33 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 66 & 67 DATED JANUARY 12, 1861 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER POST OF SECTION 35-18-11, ALSO TO DIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 INTO EAST AND WEST HALVES, ALSO TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 INTO EAST AND WEST HALVES, AND TO ESTABLISH THE BOUNDARIES OF A 40 ACRE LOT, BEING THE SOUTH PART OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 34, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE SOUTH 1/4/4 POST** OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-18-11 "AS PER A PREVIOUS SURVEY" ON THIS SURVEY.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
  - 1) 19.94 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE POST FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 35-18-11
  - 2) 20.07 CHAINS NORTH TO A STONE POST SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF A 40 ACRE LOT IN THE SOUTH PART OF THE E1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 35
  
- 3) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED MAY 03, 1989, SAID THAT **HE FOUND A CONCRETE POST** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 2-19-11 FROM RECORDS AT THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE. HE SET A 5/8" REBAR WITH HIS CAP ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE POST AND **HE SET A 1" WINDOW WEIGHT OVER THE CENTER OF THE POST.**
  - 1) 20.15' NORTH TO A STEEL FENCE POST
  - 2) IN LINE WITH CROP LINES NORTH & SOUTH
  - 3) 1.0' SOUTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF THE ROAD EAST-WEST
