

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 02, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) G. M. WALKER, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 32 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 66 DATED JANUARY 10, 1861 TO DIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 2-19-11 INTO EAST AND WEST HALVES AND ESTABLISH THE NECESSARY BOUNDS AND CORNERS, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE SOUTH 1/4/4 POST OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 2 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE POST HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER AND THE CENTER POST OF SECTION 2 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 19.94 CHAINS WEST TO THE CENTER POST OF SECTION 2
 - 2) 19.94 CHAINS EAST TO THE FOUND STONE EAST 1/4 POST OF SECTION 2
 - 3) 38.72 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE SET FOR THE N1/4/4 POST OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 2
- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 45, A PERMANENT SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 44 DATED MAY 3, 1870 TO RUN OUT THE LINES OF A 20 ACRE TRACT OF LAND LOCATED IN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 2-19-11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE EAST AND WEST LINE CROSSING THROUGH THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 2 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 1,320' SOUTH TO A STAKE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE 20 ACRE TRACT
- 2) 2,640' SOUTH TO A POST SET FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 2
